The specific areas of learning:

- English
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design



ENGLISH

At Gracefield we consider English to be central to a child's educational development. We inspire confidence in speaking, listening, reading and writing.

MATHEMATICS

We are implementing the Government's framework for teaching mathematics. Our weekly tests on multiplication tables ensure that all children have a thorough grasp of these essential skills.

SCIENCE

Children are encouraged to learn the skills and processes of science, to ask questions, communicate and share ideas.

COMPUTING

At Gracefield School we have a purpose built computer suite and every child in the school develops as an active participant in the digital world.

MUSIC

All our children are encouraged to explore, experience and control sounds made by the voice and a variety of percussion instruments.

GEOGRAPHY

Classes often take their geography learning into other fun and diverse areas and perform and present the facts they have learnt to their peers and parents.

HISTORY

History is introduced to our children in fun and interesting ways to allow them to develop an awareness of the past and the impact it has had on our present day lives.



ART AND DESIGN

Our children have the opportunity to explore and experiment with a wide variety of different techniques and skills in art.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Children enjoy fun lessons and clubs where they have the opportunity to construct models based on their designs which are often displayed around the school. We teach cooking skills and the children have the opportunity to be creative with woodworking techniques.

RE

Our RE curriculum teaches world faiths and, at Gracefield, respect and appreciation of other religions is encouraged and developed.

PSHE

The PSHE and Citizenship programme includes the use of circle time, investigations and debates to develop the children's self awareness, positive self esteem and confidence to lead healthy, active lives.

PE

Sports and physical activity plays a key part in the school week. We actively promote the understanding of the importance of exercise through a diverse range of sports and activities including swimming.

DRAMA

We place a great deal of importance on developing our children's skills and confidence in the performing arts and use drama throughout the day and across the curriculum.

LANGUAGES

We begin French in Reception and continue through to Year 6.
